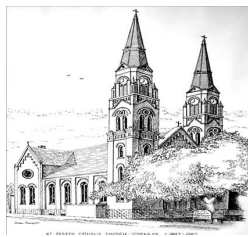

Notes from Father Tim...

Parish Council Meeting: There will be a Parish Council meeting on Thursday, March 21st at 5:30 pm in Sacred Heart Church Hall.

Finance Council Meeting: There will be a Finance Council meeting on Thursday, March 21st at 6 pm in Sacred Heart Church Hall.

Friday Stations of the Cross and Benediction: I encourage all parishioners to attend our parish Lenten Stations of the Cross and Benediction beginning at 5:30 pm each Friday of Lent at Sacred Heart Church. I also encourage you to attend our Friday Fish Suppers. Food for the soul and body on Friday nights during Lent.

Special Lenten Confession Time: I will be hearing confessions every Wednesday of Lent at 6 pm at St. Joseph Church.

Parish Lenten Project: Our Parish Lenten Project this year will be twofold. First we will use some of the funds for repairing the roof at St. Joseph Rectory, and secondly some of the proceeds will go to support the Sandwich Ministry Program. In your offertory envelope packets that are mailed to you, there is a special purple colored envelope titled "Lenten Project". Please use these special envelopes if you wish to contribute to these projects. Please make your checks out to Sacred Heart -St. Joseph Parish with the notation on the check that reads "Lenten Project" as well as writing your envelope number on the outside of the envelope if it does not already have your envelope number printed on it.

Lenten Rules for Fasting and Abstinence: Catholics age 18-59 are obligated to fast on Good Friday. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from meat on Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent. If one is in good health and is not in the above categories, they too are encouraged to follow the above rules.

Lenten Rice Bowls: Once again we will be participating in the Lenten Rice Bowl Project. Please bring your Rice Bowls to the Holy Thursday Mass on March 28th, and place them in the baskets marked "Rice Bowls" at the entrance of Sacred Heart Church. For accounting purposes, it would be helpful if you turn in a check in the amount of your collected change, rather than the change itself. Please include your name and envelope ID number with your donation. Thanks for your support.

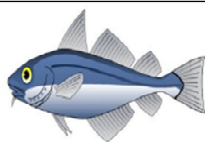
