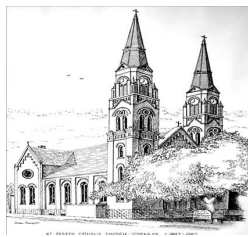

Lenten Rules for Fasting and

Abstinence: Catholics age 18-59 are obligated to fast on Good Friday. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from meat on Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent. If one is in good health and is not in the above categories, they too are encouraged to follow the above rules.

Lenten Rice Bowls: Once again we will be participating in the Lenten Rice Bowl Project. Please bring your Rice Bowls to the Holy Thursday Mass on March 28th, and place them in the baskets marked "Rice Bowls" at the entrance of Sacred Heart Church. For accounting purposes, it would be helpful if you turn in a check in the amount of your collected change, rather than the change itself. Please include your name and envelope ID number with your donation. Thanks for your support.

The Secretariat for the Synod of Bishops has requested input from dioceses on two questions. Responses to the questions will be synthesized into a short report to be submitted by each diocese to the U.S. bishops' synod team. Two listening sessions in the Archdiocese are scheduled to receive input: March 19th at Church of the Nativity Parish Hall, Leawood, and March 20th at Most Pure Heart Parish Hall. No registration needed. Both sessions begin promptly at 6:30 pm and end by 8 pm. The questions being considered exclusively are: 1) Where have I seen or experienced the church's structure(s), organization, leadership or life facilitate or hinder the church's mission of spreading the Good News of Jesus Christ? and 2) How can the structures and organization of the Church help all Christians respond to Christ's call to proclaim the Gospel and to live as a community of his love and mercy?
