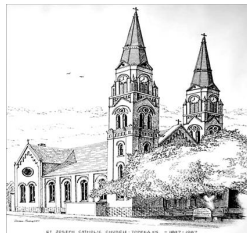

**Special Lenten Confession Time:** I will be hearing confessions every Wednesday of Lent at 6 pm at St. Joseph Church. The exception will be Wednesday, March 6th. Confessions WILL NOT be heard on Wednesday, March 6th at St. Joseph Church since all the priests from the region (including myself) will be hearing Confessions at St. Matthew Church at 7 pm that same evening for the Regional Penance Service.

**Lenten Rules for Fasting and Abstinence:** Catholics age 18-59 are obligated to fast on Good Friday. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from meat on Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent. If one is in good health and is not in the above categories, they too are encouraged to follow the above rules.

**Parish Lenten Project:** Our Parish Lenten Project this year will be twofold. First we will use some of the funds for repairing the roof at St. Joseph Rectory, and secondly some of the proceeds will go to support the Sandwich Ministry Program. In your offertory envelope packets that are mailed to you, there is a special purple colored envelope titled "Lenten Project". Please use these special envelopes if you wish to contribute to these projects. Please make your checks out to Sacred Heart -St. Joseph Parish with the notation on the check that reads "Lenten Project" as well as writing your envelope number on the outside of the envelope if it does not already have your envelope number printed on it.

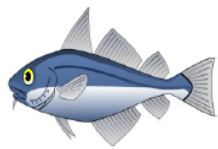
