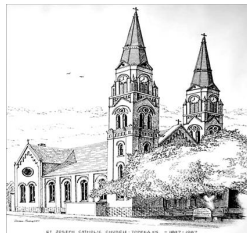

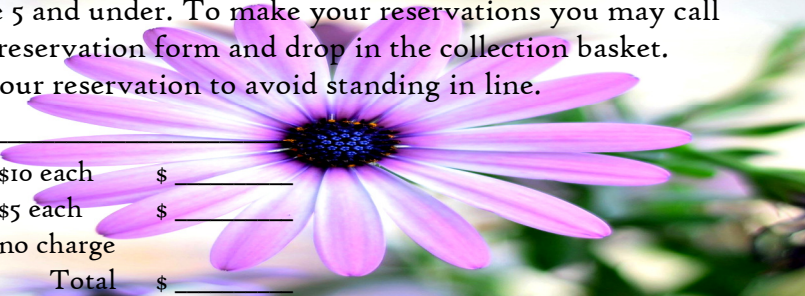
Knights News: The Knight of the Month is Steve Renyer. The Knights Family of the Month is Pat and LeAnna Baker Family.
