May is **Foster Care Awareness Month!** Every child is a unique and precious gift from God who deserves a loving family. Sadly, every day in Kansas, children are removed from their homes for a variety of reasons and through no fault of their own. Right now in Kansas there are roughly 7,000 children in care, coming from all backgrounds and from every community. Many have experienced trauma and are frightened and lonely.

Archbishop Naumann says, "To be truly pro-life, we must make sure that every child has an environment where he or she can thrive." Foster parents open their hearts and homes helping children heal, trust, and hope again. Currently there are only approximately 2,700 licensed foster families in Kansas. The Church is the solution! Everyone can help - either by becoming a foster family, supporting the families who do foster, donating necessities or gifts for children, or mentoring teens who are aging out of the system.

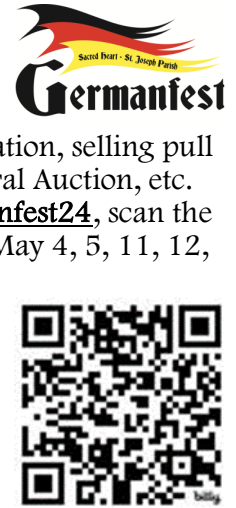

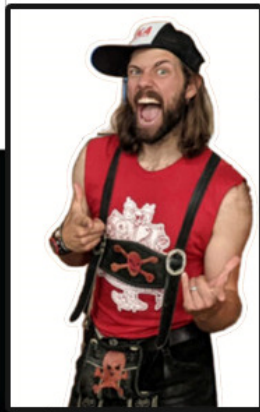
