Friday Stations of the Cross and Benediction: I encourage all parishioners to attend our parish Lenten Stations of the Cross and Benediction beginning at 5:30 pm each Friday of Lent at Sacred Heart Church. I also encourage you to attend our Friday Fish Suppers. Food for the soul and body on Friday nights during Lent.

Lenten Rules for Fasting and Abstinence:

Catholics age 18-59 are obligated to fast on Good Friday. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from meat on Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent. If one is in good health and is not in the above categories, they too are encouraged to follow the above rules.


