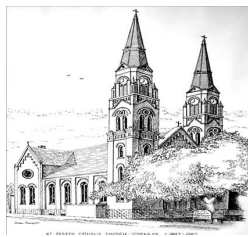

Friday Stations of the Cross and Benediction: I encourage all parishioners to attend our parish Lenten Stations of the Cross and Benediction beginning at 5:30 pm each Friday of Lent at Sacred Heart Church. I also encourage you to attend our Friday Fish Suppers. Food for the soul and body on Friday nights during Lent.

Lenten Rules for Fasting and Abstinence: Catholics age 18-59 are obligated to fast on Good Friday. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from meat on Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent. If one is in good health and is not in the above categories, they too are encouraged to follow the above rules.

Parish Lenten Project: Our Parish Lenten Project this year will be twofold. First we will use some of the funds for repairing the roof at St. Joseph Rectory, and secondly some of the proceeds will go to support the Sandwich Ministry Program. In your offertory envelope packets that are mailed to you, there is a special purple colored envelope titled "Lenten Project". SACRED HEART-ST JOSEPH FINANCE COUNCIL MINUTES

February 15, 2024

PRESENT: Father Tim Haberkorn, Matt Porubsky, Bill Pierson, Dave Konrade, and Joe Singer.

CONVENED: 5:55 PM in the Sacred Heart Church Hall

MEETING MINUTES: Amended Minutes from the January 18, 2024 meeting have been previously approved by email.

FINANCIAL REPORTS: The Council reviewed the Parish Cash Flow and Balance sheets for January 2024.

OLD BUSINESS: Insurance reimbursements for damages at Sacred Heart Church from the July 2023 storm have been received, \$4,800 for the HVAC Controller and \$525 for the above altar light, less \$1,000 deductible, total \$4,325.

The Council heard a report that a drone flight is scheduled during the third week of March, for inspection of masonry joints on the upper levels of sandstone stringcoursing on Holy Family School East Campus Building.


