

National Eucharistic Pilgrimage in Topeka



Host Sites and Pilgrimage Path, June 26-27

WED, JUNE 26th - At 3:00 pm the Eucharistic Procession will begin at the Great Overland Station (200 NW Railroad St, Topeka, KS 66608). As the pilgrimage enters Topeka, you can join as a pilgrim as the Eucharist crosses the Kansas River, passing by our local Catholic Charities, and stops at Mater Dei (Assumption church - 204 SW 8th Ave, Topeka, KS 66603) next to the Capitol Building. This route will be approximately 1.5 miles in length. Eucharistic Miracles of the World, designed by Blessed Acutos opens at 5:00 pm at Most Pure Heart of Mary Church with, Eucharistic adoration beginning at 6:00 pm followed by an Evening of Eucharistic Amazement beginning at 7:30 pm. Immediately following the evening's events, Eucharistic Adoration will be available until 7:00 am Thursday.



THU, JUNE 27th - Join us at 8:00 AM for Mass at Assumption / Mater Dei Parish, followed by a procession to Brown vs. Board of Education Park. After that, the pilgrimage will head to Corpus Christi Parish in Lawrence, KS
