SACRED HEART – ST JOSEPH FINANCE COUNCIL MINUTES

November 17, 2022

PRESENT: Father Tim Haberkorn, Rose Herman, Peggy Bybee, Matt Porubsky, Bill Pierson, Earl Flowers, and Joe Singer.

CONVENED: 6:05 PM in Sacred Heart Church Hall.

MEETING MINUTES: Amended meeting minutes from the October 2022 meeting have been previously approved by email.

FINANCIAL REPORTS: The Council reviewed the Parish Cash Flow and Balance Sheets for October 2022.

OLD BUSINESS: The Council considered an alternate bid for repair of the tile roof and guttering at St Joseph Rectory and garage from Kansas City Roofscapes in the amount of \$16,800. Recommended by vote of Council.

NEW BUSINESS: The Council considered bid estimates for repair of the roof over the North entrance atrium to Holy Family School on NE Seward Ave from Dovetail Roofing LLC in the amount of \$2,920. Recommended by vote of Council.
