If one is in good health and is not in the above categories, they too are encouraged to follow the above rules.

**Special Lenten Confession Time:** I will be hearing confessions every Wednesday of Lent at 6 pm at St. Joseph Church. The exception will be on Wednesday, April 2nd. 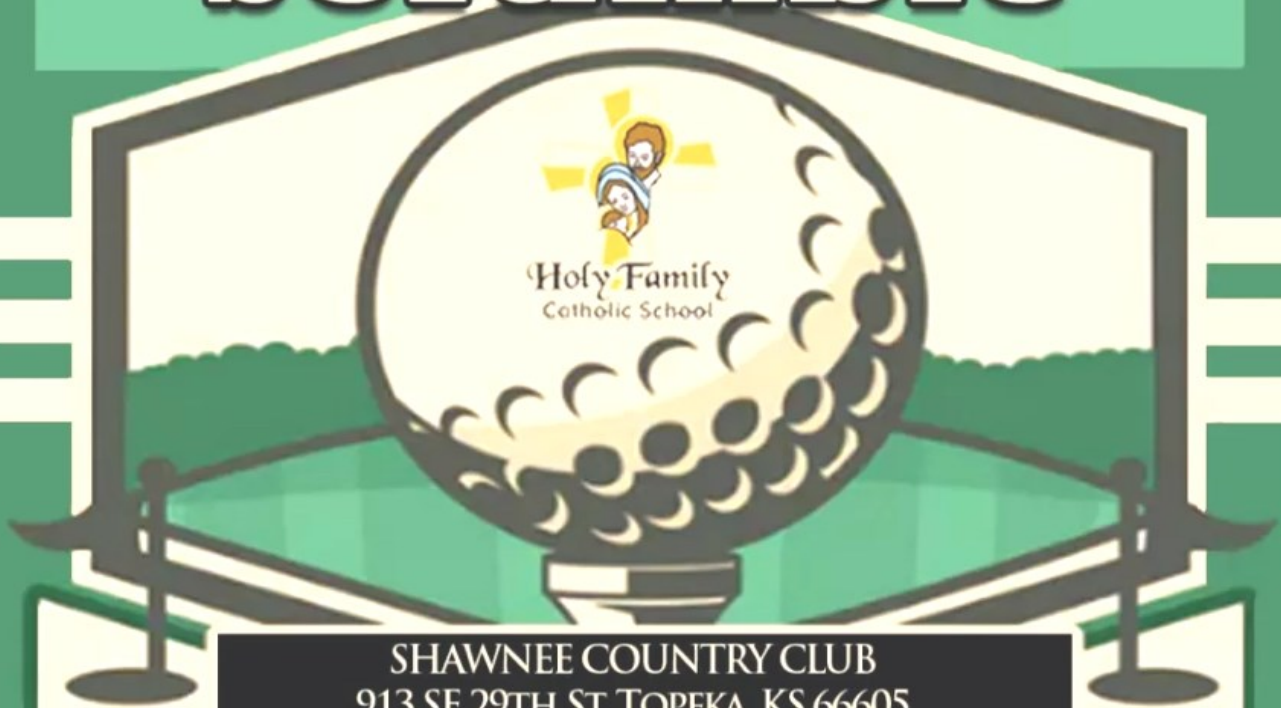
