Lenten Rules for Fasting and

Abstinence: Catholics age 18-59 are obligated to fast on Good

Friday. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent. If one is in good health and is not in the above categories, they too are encouraged to follow the above rules.

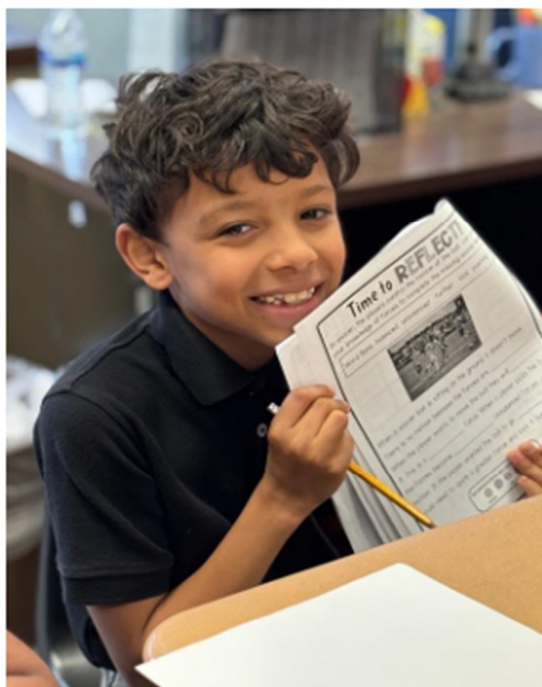
