Topeka Regional Lenten Penance Services and Confessions Schedule: ~ Tuesday, April 8th, 7 pm at Christ the King Church

Friday Stations of the Cross and Benediction: I encourage all parishioners to attend our parish Lenten Stations of the Cross and Benediction beginning at 5:30 pm each Friday of Lent at Sacred Heart Church. I also encourage you to attend our Friday Fish Suppers. Food for the soul and body on Friday nights during Lent.

Lenten Rules for Fasting and Abstinence: Catholics age 18-59 are obligated to fast on Good Friday. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent. If one is in good health and is not in the above categories, they too are encouraged to follow the above rules.

Special Lenten Confession Time: I will be hearing confessions every Wednesday of Lent at 6 pm at St. Joseph Church. The exception will be on Wednesday, April 2nd. Confessions WILL NOT be heard on Wednesday, April 2nd at St. Joseph Church, since all the priests from the region (including myself) will be hearing Confessions at St. Matthew Church at 7 pm that same evening for the Regional Penance Service.

Lenten Rice Bowls: Once again we will be participating in the Lenten Rice Bowl Project. Please bring your Rice Bowls to the Holy Thursday Mass on April 17th and place them in the baskets marked "Rice Bowls" at the entrance of Sacred Heart Church. Sacred Heart Stained-Glass Window and Lighting Upgrade Committee Report

The committee wants to thank those of you who responded to the Feasibility Study. To date we have received studies from 40% of registered parishioners. The information in the responses is very encouraging, with 88% supporting both the lighting and the windows and 98.4% willing to contribute \$0-\$4,999 over a three-year period.

Please note: This study is not a solicitation for money. We merely want to know if there is parish support for the project. The Archdiocese is the actual owner of church property and as such it is important that we have the numbers to show that the project is supported by the majority of parishioners. That is why your response to the survey is so important. If you have not yet submitted your study form, please consider filling one out. They are available in the pews and online. We want to have at least a 50% response in order for the project to move forward.

What's happening now:

In an effort to be as cost-efficient with the window and lighting project as we can, we have a couple of outside activities we are currently working on.

We have talked with a representative from Evergy regarding updating our current lighting system to an LED lighting system. By doing the upgrade we will:

- Have better lighting
- It will be more energy efficient
- It will result in an energy rebate from Evergy to help defray the cost of upgrading the system.

We are also in the process of getting the church building on the Kansas Register of Historical Places. Any building of historical significance that is more than 50 years old is eligible to apply to be on the register. The church will apply as an "Example of a Mid-Century Modern Religious Facility." It is quite a lengthy process, however the financial incentives could be significant depending on the overall cost of the project. (For example: the incentives for a \$500,000 project could be anywhere from \$13,000 to \$20,000.)

These programs will allow us access to monies through tax incentives, grants and rebates – monies we would not need to get from our parishioners.

Other activities: We have received responses to our request from interested architectural firms. Our next step is to look at stained-glass window companies and lighting contractors to come up with ideas to present to you on how to get the best product at the best price. At some point we will be able to share with you both design concepts and cost information.

In May we will have a two-part informational insert in the bulletin. It tells the story of how the design of the Sacred Heart church building came about, and some of the people of the parish who were instrumental in getting the funds to make the church building a reality.

Our plan is to keep you updated as information becomes available. We will use the tools we have which include the Sunday Bulletin, the sacredheartstjosephcatholic.org Web page and our Facebook page.

We want to thank you for your support of this exciting project for our parish. We are grateful to you and to the earlier parish members who made this beautiful example of modern architecture possible, many of whom are your ancestors.

New Family Referral Program

Greetings parents and guardians!

We would like to introduce a New Family Referral Program. This program gives existing HFCS families incentive to recruit new families to our school. The reward for referring a new family is a \$100 tuition discount.

Who is Eligible?

Families with any children enrolled in PreK-8th grade at Holy Family.

Is there a limit?

There is no limit to how many new families can be recruited. The existing family will receive \$100 for every family they refer.

How will Holy Family know who referred the new family?

During the registration process, the new family will officially designate which family referred them to enroll at Holy Family.

What if a new family enrolls at HFCS and no one referred them?

The family should notify the school as soon as it is known that a family is interested in having their children attend Holy Family. If the referral is not prior to the new student(s) registering, there will be no referral discount.

What if the current family tuition bill is less than the amount of the discount?

Families with a tuition bill less than their referral discount will still be credited their full discount; however, the credit will roll over to subsequent years.

Special circumstances may occur. Holy Family retains the right to reevaluate, revise or cancel this program at any time.
