Germanfest Weekend Mass Schedule:
As we have done in the past, there will be only two parish Masses on the weekend of Germanfest, June 1st and 2nd. The two Masses will be at 4 pm on Saturday, June 1st, and 8 am on Sunday, June 2nd. There will not be a 10:30 am Mass.
