## Sacred Heart – St Joseph Finance Council Minutes

May 16, 2019

**Present:** Father Tim Haberkorn, Bill Pierson, Sam Leone, Bruce Danielson, (Ron Meier, Rose Herman, Al Kirmer)-new members, (Mark Burghart, Ann Meier, and Jackie Carlson)-expired term.

**Convened:** 6:10 p.m. in Sacred Heart Church Hall.

Minutes from the last meeting were approved.

**Financial Reports:** The council reviewed and approved the March financial reports. The budget was reviewed line by line, changes were made, and the council unanimously approved the budget.

**New Business:** Dennis Lawlor and Kenny Gragg presented information regarding the upkeep of Holy Family School. Kenny and Dennis provided details of the maintenance plan and a replacement plan on an ongoing basis costing approximately \$1,500 a year for general maintenance to ensure the equipment in the school is running properly. There are some repairs they suggested to the school and to the roof to avoid a larger expense down the road. The council approved unanimously for Kenny and Dennis to move forward with the maintenance plan and improvements.

Bruce requested new tires for the trailer to haul the chairs and tables for Germanfest that will cost \$1,600. Approved unanimously.

Bruce Danielson was elected as president and Sam Leone as secretary for the next term.

The Fourth Degree Knights would like to donate a bench in Fr. George Klasinski's name. Father Tim encouraged them to donate the bench in his honor and place it at the Mausoleum in Mount Calvary Cemetery.

Father Mark Ostrowski will be ordained in Kansas City the weekend of May 18<sup>th</sup>. The parish will present him a gift of \$500.

**Lenten Projects:** The Lenten project raised \$24,000, the Altar Society donated \$10,000, and the parish budgeted \$10,000 which makes a total of \$44,000 towards the budgeted \$38,000 to paint of the outside of Sacred Heart Church.

**St. Joseph's Restoration:** The restoration is going as planned.

**Next Meeting:** The meeting will be held at 6:00 pm, August 15th in Sacred Heart Church Hall. No parish council meeting in August.

**Adjournment:** The meeting was adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
