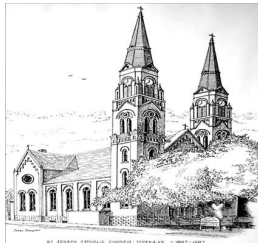

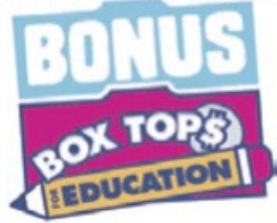

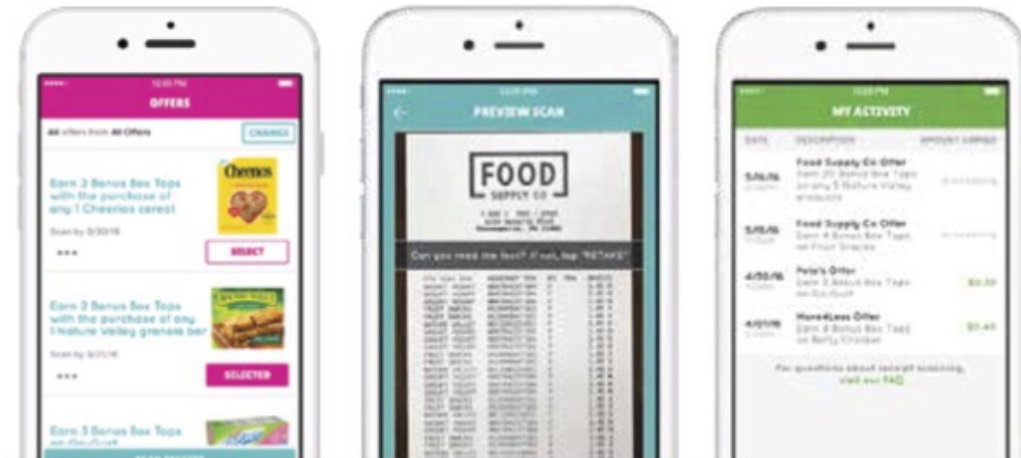

Hudson was born May 24, 2018. Shortly after birth it was discovered that Hudson's right ear had not formed, and he struggled to breathe and swallow. At five hours old, Hudson was taken, via life-flight, to Children's Mercy Hospital in Kansas City, MO. In the days to come he would undergo his first surgery, and countless tests and procedures. The results would show Hudson has VACTERL-S Association. VACTERL-S is a rare non-genetic disorder. VACTERL-S is an acronym. Each letter represents one type of defect. A baby must have 3 defects to fall under this association. V (vertebral defects) A (anal atresia) C (cardiac defects) T (tracheoesophageal fistula) E (esophageal atresia) R (renal defects) L (limb defects) S (single umbilical artery). Hudson was born with VCTES. After his 1st birthday, Hudson was also diagnosed with Goldenhar Syndrome. For Hudson, it has resulted in a missing right ear, permanent hearing loss in the left ear, a small recessed jawbone and facial palsy. In his short life he has overcome surgeries to repair his trachea and esophagus, tethered spinal cord release, and place a feeding tube. He is currently followed by 13 different specialty clinics. Hudson requires a hearing aid to be able to hear and interpret speech sounds. He remains dependent on his feeding tube for the majority of his nutrition.

Despite all the setbacks and struggles, Hudson continues to fight and smiles his way through all of it. His bright disposition brings joy to everyone who encounters him. He is a genuinely happy and immensely loved little



boy. Your donation will help allow Hudson to receive the best possible medical care and provide financial stability to his family as they face lost wages due to frequent need for medical care and appointments.
