The Overturning of Roe v Wade was the news that we waited and prayed for. Praise be to God. While we should rejoice over this decision, we must also remember that it does not change what we are facing in Kansas and, in fact, makes the passage of Value Them Both even more important. Statements of the Bishops of Kansas and Archbishop Naumann's personal statement are at archkck.org/u-s-supreme-court-ruling-on-dobbs-ushers-in-a-new-abortion-landscape.
