First Reconciliation/ First Holy Communion Candidates and Parents Meeting:

This special meeting is **Sunday, August 25th at 11 am** in Sacred Heart Church for Confirmation student candidates who belong to Sacred Heart-St. Joseph Parish and are in the 7th and 8th grades for the 2024-2025 school year.
