Our Mission:

To serve and honor God, the Church, and our parish families through restoring, creating, and maintaining Church gardens and landscapes, providing a place of beauty and peaceful repose throughout the year for our parishioners. We wish to enjoin all interested persons in helping us bring new life around the parish, as we create new life within. Genesis tells us that God created and loved his garden. **Life began in a garden...**

2018-2019 Accomplishments: (We've been working the grounds at St. Joseph this year)

- North side of Rectory; pulled weeds, planted fragrant flowering Hostas, and laid natural river rock.
- South side; cleaned out weeds, planted spring bulbs, added natural river rock.
- East-side, in front of Rectory; pulled weeds, laid river rock, kept large porch urns filled with flowers.
- Grotto (St. Joseph's statue); cleaned out trash and weeds, dug up and saved original bulbs for spring planting.
- West-side (behind rectory); cleaned out back gardens and porch/patio areas, cleaned and set up patio furniture, set out a "patio-pooch" doghouse for Hans.
- Rectory Garage (a project of biblical proportion), was prayed over, wept over, then cleaned out, washed up, swept, re swept, and now things are starting to get organized!

Autumn 2019 and 2020 Hopes and Goals:

- **Increase Garden Club Members within our parish; coverage for all church grounds and gardens.**
- Plant dwarf conifers (little Christmas trees!) in front of St. Joseph Rectory gardens.
- Install nice bench near sidewalk in front of St. Joseph Church.
- Plant small ornamental shade tree near new bench.
- Develop St. Joseph Grotto area with new gardens and a bench.
- Obtain new, safe shelving units for Rectory garage
- Develop ideas around planting small **Heritage Gardens**, to honor the founding families of our parish. Plant herbs, flowers, etc. from the Lower Volga River Region and the early German States. Consider recording historical notes from old letters & stories regarding their ancestor's gardens, herbal remedies, old German recipes, etc.

- Donate your time! Volunteer to engage in gardening projects. (If you prefer to supervise...please bring beer!)
- Donate new or *gently-used* lawn and garden equipment, tools, and/or supplies, etc.
