Friday Stations of the Cross and Benediction: I encourage all parishioners to attend our parish Lenten Stations of the Cross and Benediction, beginning at 5:30 pm each Friday of Lent at Sacred Heart Church. I also encourage you to attend our Friday Fish Suppers. Food for the soul and body on Friday nights during Lent.

Lenten Rules for Fasting and Abstinence: Catholics age 18-59 are obligated to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and All Fridays of Lent. If one is in good health and is not in the above categories, they too are encouraged to follow the above rules.

Parish Lenten Project: Our Parish Lenten Project this year will go toward the exterior painting of Sacred Heart Church. The Church desperately needs to be painted to prevent the wood from rotting. In your offertory envelope packets that are mailed to you, there is a special purple colored envelope titled "Lenten Project".
